Dean Trepal Congratulates Class of 2016 for a Strong Performance in Match

Michael J. Trepal, DPM ('81), Vice President for Academic Affairs and Dean sent in this report on the 2016 match: "As previously reported, 100% of the class of 2016 is eligible for residency placement by virtue of passing Part II APMLE exams. This in itself is admirable. Specific to the 2016 match, 84 out of 88 NYCPM students have been placed, most in programs high up on their personal rankings, if not number one. Nationally there were 535 members of the class of 2016 who along with 61 graduates from prior years (total applicant pool of 596) applied to 577 available positions. Nationally, 16 students from 2016 and 25 from prior years are still seeking placement.

"I want to congratulate the Class of 2016 for a very strong performance. We have received extremely positive feedback from many program directors who are thrilled with their matches. I also want to thank the faculty and especially Dr. Eckles, who worked very hard mentoring many students and helping those who did not match in the first round to secure placement in subsequent rounds. Graduate placement remains a top priority for the College and we will continue to work very hard to help open new positions and to seek placement for those still in need.
