Currently, Mr. Alberti serves as the President and Founder of Cross River International, Inc., a consulting firm providing management and transactional advisory services to both regulatory and private clients in the insurance market space. He also serves as a member of the Board of Directors of TREK, an insurance holding company, and its subsidiary, American Medical and Life Insurance Company of New York. His past service has included the Boards of Directors of Western United Life Assurance Company of Spokane, Washington; Millbrook Inc., an information and technology architecture firm; Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center; and the Merchants Group, Inc., an insurance holding company, and its subsidiary, Merchants Insurance Company of New Hampshire.
