Michael Rossidis Wins Stone Award at ACFAS



This month, Michael Rossidis (2016) received the Michael Stone Outstanding Professional Conduct Award at the Annual meeting of the American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgeons held in conjunction with The American College of Foot and Ankle Surgeons' Annual Scientific Conference, Feb. 11-14 2016 in Austin, Texas. The ABFAS, the American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery, presents this award annually to one fourth-year student from each of the nine podiatric schools.

Rossidis is the Class of 2016 Student Ambassador, President of the Wound Care/Diabetes Club of NYCPM, and Editor-in-Chief of the 2015 NYCPM Podiatric Medical Review. There had not been a PMR since 2012, and Rossidis approached the job of publishing a new edition with strong enthusiasm and goals. Writing in the introduction to the PMR, he stated that "Research is our profession's most powerful asset to further strengthen our standing in the medical field ... I want readers to sense the passion and effort that was put into creating this student-run publication and to use its contents to strengthen their own knowledge and to improve the care of their patients."
