Bijan Andrade, NYCPM Class of 2012, has been chosen as this year's Student of the Year by the American Podiatric Medical Students Association (APMSA). Only one student nationwide is chosen. Each school nominated one person, and the school presidents then each presented their candidate. Presidents judged the candidates on their CV and an essay from the prompt "What obstacles have you faced in your life outside your podiatric medical student career that you feel have helped shape you or will shape you into a better doctor of podiatric medicine?" Bijan's history of helping his fellow students at NYCPM, as well as his research experience, stood out the most to the presidents' committee.
