### **STANLEY R. KALISH, DPM, LECTURES AND CONDUCTS CADAVER SURGERY WORKSHOP FOR NYCPM RESIDENTS**



*Stanley R. Kalish, DPM, conducted a resident surgical workshop on ankle fusions using tibial nails held in NYCPM's recently-renovated, state-of-the-art Anatomy Lab and Skills Center following a lecture he gave at the College.*

Stanley R. Kalish, DPM, a renowned Atlanta, GA-based podiatric surgeon and distinguished NYCPM alumnus who has lectured and taught widely, recently gave a well-received student lecture and resident surgical workshop on ankle fusions using tibial nails. The lecture, entitled "Complex Ankle/Hindfoot Arthrodesis Utilizing the Phoenix nail", was supported by an educational grant from Biomet, Inc., a company that designs, manufactures, and markets products used primarily by musculoskeletal medical specialists in both surgical and non-surgical therapy. Dr. Kalish first presented a didactic lecture to third- and fourth-year students, and then conducted an intensive workshop that utilized fresh cadavers in the College's recently-renovated, state-of-the-art Anatomy Lab and Skills Center.
