New Appointment and Changes in Student Services Announced; Laurence Lowy to Retire as Dean, Will Become Advisory Dean; Lisa Lee to Succeed Lowy as Dean, Both Effective July 1



Announcing the new NYCPM faculty/staff appointments were: President and CEO Louis L. Levine; Michael J. Trepal, DPM ('81), FACFAS, VP of Academic Affairs and Dean; Lisa Lee, current Dean of Enrollment Management; Laurence Lowy, DPM, current Dean for Student Services; Joel Sturm, COO.

On May 11, President and CEO Louis L. Levine, Michael J. Trepal, DPM, VP for Academic Affairs and Dean, and Joel A. Sturm, COO and VP for Administration, announced two changes within the Department of Student Services – Laurence Lowy, DPM, Dean for Student Services, has decided to retire from that position, but will remain with NYCPM part time in an advisory capacity, and Lisa Lee, currently the Dean for Enrollment Management, will succeed Dr. Lowy as Dean for Student Services.

Dr. Lowy has been with NYCPM since 1994. The announcement described him as “the silent man of action” whose work as Dean was praised as “instrumental in the success of our school and graduates.” He will now hold the newly created position of Advisory Dean, in which he will report to Dr. Trepal on institutional policies.

Ms. Lee joined NYCPM in 2001. Under her guidance as Dean for Enrollment Management, NYCPM has seen an enrollment increase comprised of students with higher GPA and MCAT scores than in previous years. As Dean she will be responsible for managing the whole department of Student Services including the Office of the Registrar, Enrollment Management and Housing.

“Under Dr. Lowy’s and Ms. Lee’s leadership, Student Services has consistently performed above expectations,” noted President Levine.
