The Insurance fee is collected each semester only from those students who elect the coverage arranged by the College. National Board fees are collected from eligible board candidates and forwarded to the National Board with their applications. Students needing to retake Boards pay additional Board fees. All tuition and fee payments should be made payable (via check, MasterCard or Visa) to the New York College of Podiatric Medicine and directed to the Office of the Bursar.

LESS THAN FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT

Students enrolled for less than a full course load for any semester will be charged tuition and fees according to the following schedule:

- A) Twelve (12) credits/hours or more: Full tuition responsibility
- B) Eleven (11) credits/hours or less: \$650 per credit hour

C) Fees are not prorated and will be assessed at full value as appropriate

RETESTING FEES

The fee for remediation of a course is \$50 per test.

Tuition Refunds

Students who officially withdraw (demonstrated by a duly executed letter by the Dean) or are otherwise separated from the College will receive refunds of **tuition** according to the schedule and percentages listed below:

If Official Withdrawal Occurs:	Charge	Refund
Within the First Three Weeks of a semester	40%	60%
During the Fourth Week of a semester	60%	40%
During the Fifth Week of a semester	80%	20%
After the Fifth Week of a semester	100%	No Refund
