Notes:

1. Students are pre-registered in classroom settings for convenience. This procedure does not imply either academic or financial eligibility for registration.
2. Students who fail to qualify for registration by regular registration dates are subject to late registration, which must occur before published late registration end dates. Permission to attend classes prior to registering does not imply the right to register nor to receive academic credit.
3. “College and Clinic closed” **does not refer to status of clinical rotations at hospitals.** “Clinic” refers to FCNY. Students are responsible to attend all rotations at off-campus facilities regardless of closures of NYCPM and FCNY.
4. Class recess dates often (not always) coincide with study/retest periods for those students who need to retest. Students who do not need to retest should not assume that such periods represent recess time; recess dates are stated separately.
