James Warren Jr. has been Director of Security at NYCPM since 1999, and is responsible for the security and safety of patients, staff, students and visitors to the College and Foot Center of New York. In his role, he also responsible for fire safety, disaster and evacuation plans; safety policies and the surveillance system; ID cards and transportation for students, staff and authorized personnel; and three parking lots and their related authorizations. Prior to joining NYCPM, Mr. Warren was Director of the Hospital Police Academy; he was based at Harlem Hospital Center, where he developed a program for the entire hospital police staff that focused on the interpersonal skills needed to relate to the hospital's community at large, patients, staff and, with a psychiatrist, emotionally disturbed patients.
