

Keith Crenshaw Named NYCPM Winner of 2022 Michael L. Stone Award



On November 13th, Michael J. Trepal, DPM, FACFAS, VP of Academic Affairs and Dean, announced that **Keith Crenshaw (2022)** is the NYCPM winner of the **2022 Michael L. Stone Outstanding Professional Conduct Award**, presented by the American Board of Foot and Ankle Surgery (ABFAS). The prize was determined by the NYCPM Scholarship Committee, working in conjunction with the Department of Surgery. "It was a most difficult endeavor as they had to choose among many well qualified candidates," said Dr. Trepal.

As winner, Keith will receive a cash award, a plaque of recognition, and fully paid registration, hotel and travel to the annual ACFAS Meeting, this year in Austin, TX, Feb. 24-27, 2022. Drs. Trepal and Jules will be present as Mr. Crenshaw receives his award.

The annual award is named after the late Michael L. Stone, DPM, a past president of ABFAS, and is presented each year to one graduating senior from each of the country's nine podiatric medical schools who exemplifies the highest standard of professionalism, deportment, and ethics in interactions with peers, patients, professors, and staff.

"I knew Dr. Stone well, having served with him on the ABPS Board," said Dr. Trepal, "and I am quite certain that if he were here today, he would be thrilled not only with the winner, but also with the quality of the runner-ups."
